

#### **Updates – Cont'd**

<u>Kate Dean noted</u> the County is supportive of CHIP and actively working to identify the best path forward.

<u>Lexa Murphy noted</u> currently her work with kids carries as ense of "acute and high need".

Molly Parker noted JHC is working internally to update screening protocols.

Jim Novelli conveyed he is speaking with Ciela Meyers on school counseling-related topics.

<u>Ciela Meyers gave</u> a status update on school counseling services. She is working to finalize having ESD 114 take on the 1/10<sup>th</sup> of 1% SBHC counseling contract and administer it with subrecipients MCS Counseling and DBH. Goal is to keep original counselors in the school, add days and add individual licensed therapists as possible.

<u>Jean Scarborough overviewed</u> Jumping Mouse's school engagement. Work with kids age 2-12 in Brinnon and Chimacum school district currently, and have plans to build out a therapy room next Fall for long-term therapy in Chimacum.

<u>Denise Banker updated</u> the group on status of ETC's effort to offer a standard program of mental health promotion and suicide prevention training to all 4 school districts. MCS/DBH/ETC met with Ciela Meyer to review her list of possible evidence-based programs. From there Commissioner Brotherton and Denise went to Joint Superintendents meeting and secured their commitment to initiate choosing standard programming from that list for all four school districts at their next meeting. Once the programming is chosen, ETC will pursue funding for the effort. Denise also noted she is stepping into the role of JCPH Community Health Director, but will be presiding over a very warm hand-off of the ETC efforts underway and ensuring the effort with the Joint Board reaches successful completion.
